# Sunday August 24th: TacRifle Season Finale!

#### The Best of the Year

We get 5 full ranges all day long, so we can setup the best of the best stages! Likely candidates will be a 100 yard challenge with run down to 50, a pneumatic pop-up challenge, a fully blind stage, a "vehicle" scene (plywood "cars") and some kind of skill builder challenge.



## **Registration is Limited to 60 Participants**

Given the number of ROs we have and amount of space, we are limiting this match to 60 participants. Priority will be given in the following order:

- Match Directors
- Match ROs
- People who help setup (especially if you've helped setup before this match)
- Members of TMAR/TMSA (especially if you've attended a work party and contributed to the club)
- And then its first come first serve!

If you get wait listed, we will still allow you to enter the draw. However you must be present during registration and pay the full match fee even if you don't get to shoot. Anyone wait-listed can still show-up on the day of and hope someone else doesn't show up in time for registration (always someone) and claim their spot. If a spot doesn't open up, you can still hang around and put your name in for a chance at one of three AR15 door prizes, tons of gift cards and other loot! Other restrictions:

- No totally new participants, if this would be your first ever rifle competition, please come back in September ("off-season") when everything is a little more relaxed and you can take your time to learn at your skill level. To participate in this match you need to have attended several other rifle competitions in the last 2 years.
- No sharing rifle or gear. In line with the above, we ask that you have your own rifle and magazines by now. We try to accommodate people sharing gear all year long but because of the size of the August match we ask that everyone have their own gear to work with! This saves time and confusion.
- No shoot-throughs.

# When Should I Arrive?

Arrive at 8:00 am for registration/setup, registration at 8:30am, safety briefing at 8:45 am. DO NOT ARRIVE AT 8:30am, arrive earlier and be done unloading your stuff and registering before 8:30am. If you miss the safety meeting/registration, you cannot participate, so don't be late! We have all 5 ranges all day on Sunday! No time crunches on the rifle range. This is the one match a year to ask for a little extra time from your significant other. We'll probably go a little later in the day as we get to setup the best of all stages all year.

### What do I need to bring?

- \$40 match fee, free BBQ and drinks near sponsor tents!
- A reliable shoulder-mounted semi-auto center-fire firearm (AR-15, XCR, Tavor, etc.. pistol caliber carbines ok too)
- 5 or more 5 round magazines (each stage may require up to 26 rounds, 6 or more magazines gives you a spare one in case you fumble or have a malfunction)
- Alternatively, if your firearm accepts pistol magazines... 3 or more 10 round magazines.
- Minimum of 140 rounds of ammunition (150-200 rounds recommended if you are not a "perfect shot")

- High Visibility Chamber Flag (CTC Supplies usually has some onsite for a minimum \$2 donation to a good cause)
- Eye Protection
- Hearing Protection
- Quality boots or shoes (It can get muddy and the ground is not even hiking boots are great!)
- Load bearing gear to hold 5+ magazines (cargo pants with leg pockets can work if you're new, they'll just be slower than a dedicated belt or chest rig)
- Backpack or range bag to carry extra supplies (more ammo, snacks, sunscreen, bug spray, pair of work gloves for cleanup)
- Appropriate outdoor clothing we shoot rain or shine
